Transfer of Depreciation to operating cash (Separation of RMLP Accounts from Town)

This past year we were in the red in the area of \$650,000, so the town treasure thought it was in the best interest of the town to have the RMLP start their own account.

• Capital Spending – Calendar year to date May of 2019 \$117,531.99

Total: **\$650,208.94**
